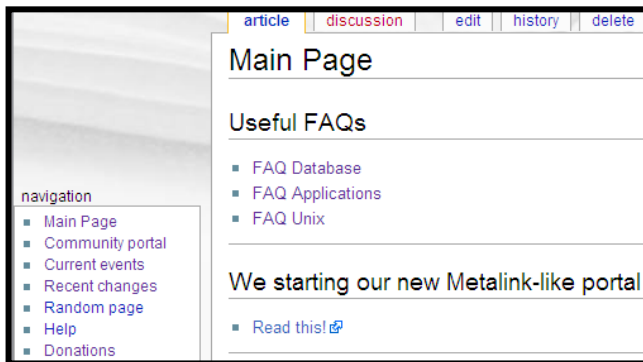

Boston SoftDesign Announces “The Whole Megillah™” Wiki Collaboration Software for Oracle DBA Activities

Boston — April 3, 2008 — Today Boston SoftDesign (BSD) announced a new product, “The Whole Megillah™”, a wiki collaboration tool. Megillah is a central repository for all DBA functions and activities. Patch logs and procedures are kept in an on-line wiki and are edited and updated as necessary. “Megillah” is the Hebrew word for scroll and is commonly used to refer to the “Book of Esther” which is read aloud during the Jewish Purim holiday. “The whole megillah” is used to describe a story where every detail is included.



Oracle database administrators document all work done on an Oracle database. Other individuals involved in the DBA process may also add or edit information based on login security. The tool is especially useful for teams of DBAs working together and for clients who

want a record of the process.

Boston SoftDesign provides offshore and domestic DBA solutions to Oracle functional and technical partners. Megillah is provided to BSD partner clients at no additional charge. In an E-Business Suite upgrade Megillah helps assure that the same procedures are followed as the project moves from the test instance to development and finally into production.

BSD hopes to have a prototype of “Megillah” completed by the start of Collaborate 08 and will be demoing at Booth # 1542 as well as at the Agate A Hospitality Suite at the Hyatt Regency on Tuesday, April 15th at 7 PM.
